One Program...Two Options

Traditional Parent's Day Out: Children attend two days per week throughout the school year. Tuition is payable monthly. Registration fee required.

Drop-In Care: For those who only occasionally need childcare, drop-in care is available. **Reservations are Required 24 hrs in advance.** Drop-in fee is payable when child arrives.

Both Options available Mondays & Wednesdays from 9am-2pm.

Enrollment and Tuition

Enrolling:

Children ages 1 yr (as of Sept 1, 2010) through PreK

Program Days & Times:

Monday's & Wednesday's 9:00am-2:00pm

Fall 2010 Session Begins:

September 13, 2010

Spring 2011 Session Begins:

January 10, 2011

Registration /Supply Fee:

\$50 per child is payable at Registration and again in January at start of Spring Session *Non-refundable*

Tuition:

Regular Program is \$145/month

Tuition is due on the first Monday of each month

Drop-In Care Rate is \$25 per day

Fee is payable when child arrives
