The flowering of the cross has been an Easter tradition at Trinity for many years. The flowering represents the transition from Good Friday to Easter, from meditation on Jesus' death to joyful celebration of his resurrection. The ceremony transforms a barren cross, a reminder of Jesus' death, into an Easter symbol. Covered with fresh, living flowers the cross serves not only as an emblem of Jesus' resurrection but also of the continuing presence of Christ among today's Christians. We will be flowering the cross on Easter Sunday at both of our campuses.

On the Mulberry campus, children will gather before worship at 8:45am in the foyer of the Sanctuary. The children will be given flowers to put on the cross. All children are invited to participate; parents of young children are encouraged to join us as we walk down the center aisle to the stage placing our flowers on the cross.

At TriPoint, families are invited to get a flower upon entering the doors before the 11:30am worship service. The cross will be in the welcome area. Everyone is invited to flower the cross at the TriPoint Campus.
