LESSONS FROM KELSEY GRAMMER

Last month I was thrilled to attend an event where Kelsey Grammer was the keynote speaker. In my young adult life, I watched him on every episode of "Cheers" and his hit show "Frazier." Kelsey experienced tremendous loss as a young person through the deaths of his father, his sister, and his two stepbrothers in random violent acts. He spent much of his adult life in deep grief resulting in him turning to unhealthy ways to cope. Recently he starred in the movie, "The Jesus Revolution" which resulted in him turning to a new life in Christ.

He was so funny as he talked about the sitcoms he starred in and then would weep openly about the grief of the losses he had experienced. True vulnerability. Then the conversation shifted, and Kelsey was asked, "If you were president of the United States what would you do?" Without hesitation he said, "teach manners." He continued by talking about how we treat one another, not whether we agree with each other, BUT how we TREAT each other. He emphasized the importance of parents teaching things like saying thank you and please. He said, "It seems simple, but it makes a difference."

I sat there reflecting on what I could bring back to share with you on your parenting journey and this is what came to me: "Good job, parents." I want to strongly re-enforce how thankful I am for the parents at Trinity. From the moment your children walk

in the door of the children's building I hear your prompting, "say hello." I hear you thank the teachers and leaders who invest in your kids and then guide your chidlren to do the same. You ARE teaching and modeling manners which does show God's love to others. So as Kelsey finished, I thought, "Wow, I serve in a great place where parents really do partner with us to help guide their children."

I did get to meet Kelsey and after he firmly established my overzealous enthusiasm that I was indeed a fan, he asked me what I did and I said, "I am a children's pastor." He looked at me, and as his eyes welled with









tears, he said, "What you do is so important, don't ever stop."

I know you live in a world full of pressure and it is hard to know what the score card is for your parenting. I just want to encourage you and tell you, "YOU ARE DOING A GREAT JOB and it matters!"
